Student Mentoring and Diversity Coordinator

Coordinates Unit contact with students in degree-granting programs for the purpose of providing information about scholarship opportunities and Unit activities and to recruit them as new SLA members

Duties:

- Represents the profession and SLA by participating in and/or promoting career day activities, awareness programs, library school presentations and mentoring projects. Past activities have included the Library Professional Association Day at St. Catherine's University (typically April/May if it occurs).
- 2. Notifies library/information science schools with Minnesota-based students of all Chapter activities, and invites both students and faculty to attend Chapter activities.
- 3. Provides students and faculty with information on special libraries and the benefits of SLA membership.
- 4. Works with the other committees to plan and advertise programs and services that foster the building of mentoring relationships among members of the Chapter.
- 5. Attends and presents annual report at the Chapter annual business meeting.
- 6. Monitors student-related, and diversity events for opportunities to promote SLA to these groups.
- 7. Submits news to the Chapter bulletin and website that would be of interest to students and members, especially as it relates to career opportunities and diversity activities.
